„Concerto Piccolo” gives the opportunity to relish one of the most splendid and valuable historical organ in the outstanding acoustics of Riga Dome. The organ of Riga Dome is one of the greatest achievements of the art of organ building in the late Romantic Period

The artistic style known as "Nouveau" first appeared at the turn of the century, and certainly was a fresh approach and stunning in its diversity - from ornate entrances, building facades to minimalistic detail, Art Nouveau considered functionality as a key guiding light for the new look - interior design and selection of furnishings with many innovative touches. Riga was one of the cities at the forefront of the style's active use, and the examples of it are truly bold and vibrant
