Friday, 15 February

- **Breakfast** at the hotel. Gathering in the hotel lobby
- **Site inspections** in the hotels Swissôtel and Radisson Blu Sky Hotel - hotels are Convene 2019 exhibitors.
- **Guided walk in Tallinn Medieval Old Town** combined with site inspections and a taste of incentive activities. Venues to be visited: Town Hall, House of the Brotherhood of Black Heads etc.
- **Visit to Seaplane Harbour**, the biggest unique gala dinner and reception venue in Tallinn.

Seaplane Harbour (Estonian Maritime Museum) operates in architecturally unique hangars built almost a century ago, in 1916 and 1917, as a part of Peter the Great sea fortress. These hangars are the World's first reinforced concrete shell structures of this magnitude.

- **Lunch**
- **Visit to the Tallinn Creative Hub**, the newest unique venue.

This inspiring space makes its home in an old, brick building that served as the Tallinn City Central Power Station from 1913 to 1979. Since the completion of renovations in autumn 2015, the complex has been available for hosting a variety of large events and activities.

- **Visit to Kadriorg** – Presidential, yet cosy and romantic inner-city area nearby the coast can very well be the place where you will find the heart of Tallinn.

Kadriorg palace and art museum surrounded by manicured Kadriorg Park was once established by Tsar Peter the Great as a manifestation of love. There are a number of museums in the park, including KUMU (the Estonian Art Museum) and Kadriorg Art Museum, which are also unique venues for events.
