Thursday, 14 February

- 15:50** **Flight Vilnius – Gdansk**
Flight with layover in Warsaw
- 18:15** **Arrival to Gdansk**
Pick-up at airport and check-in at Hampton by Hilton Old Town
The hotel is located in the very heart of the City.
- 19:30** **Welcome dinner** at Piwnica Rajców Restaurant

Friday, 15 February

- 9:00** **Gathering in the hotel lobby**
- 9:30** **Visit to Amber Expo Exhibition and Convention Centre**
The complex consists of three integrated exhibition halls, with a total area of 12,000 m2.
- 10:30** **Visit to Stadium Energa Gdansk**
236 m long, 203 m wide, 45 m tall and shining like amber in the sun. Gdansk Stadium is considered to be amongst the most beautiful football arenas in Europe.





12:00 **Guided tour along the Royal Route**

The Royal Route was the longest urban axis of European Middle Ages. The route goes through amazing market of Gdansk, closed by the Green Gate on the side of the Motława River.

13:30 **Visit to Gdansk Shakespeare Theatre**

It is the only Shakespearian theatre in Poland. Inspired by the former Elizabethan playhouse, the high-tech facility with unique opening roof was designed by Italian architect Renato Rizzi.

14:30 **Lunch at Hotel Sadova & site inspection**

Location in the very heart of bustling Gdansk makes Hotel Sadova one of the city's calling card.

16:00 **Visit to the Polish Baltic Philharmonic**

The Polish Baltic Frédéric Chopin Philharmonic is the largest music institution in the northern Poland.

17:00 **Visit to the II World War Museum**

The Museum that shows in detail the entirety of the 6 year long conflict. It is located in the center of Gdansk, the city where the most tragic conflict in the history of humankind began.

19:20 **Hilton Gdansk site inspection**

Set in the heart of the Old Town and overlooking the Motława River, Hilton Gdansk is an ideal location for business and leisure.

20:00 **Dinner and drinks in Bowke Restaurant**

Place where you can feel the atmosphere of the harbor from more than 200 years ago and enjoy the taste of Polish cuisine and the finest wines.





Saturday, 16 February

- 9:00** **Gathering in the lobby**
- 9:15** **Visit to European Solidarity Centre**
It is a state-of-the-art cultural institution that honours our greatest civic success—the victorious Solidarity movement
- 10:30** **Transfer to Sopot with tourist guide on board**
Sopot is a famous health resort and spa. The streets are crowded and full of cafes, restaurants and art galleries
- 11:00** **Walk along the Monte Cassino Street**
- 12:15** **Visit to Sofitel Grand Sopot**
Hotel with distinctive and glamorous architecture, a widely recognized. Meticulously refurbished in Art Nouveau style, it overlooks the beach and the Bay
- 13:00** **Visit to Sheraton Sopot Hotel, Conference Center & Spa**
It is a luxurious, 5 star hotel located by the sea and the longest wooden pier in Europe, near the famous pedestrian promenade - Monte Casino Street
- 13:00** **Lunch and transfers to the Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport**
Lunch at the Sheraton Sopot Hotel restaurant
